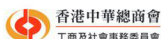

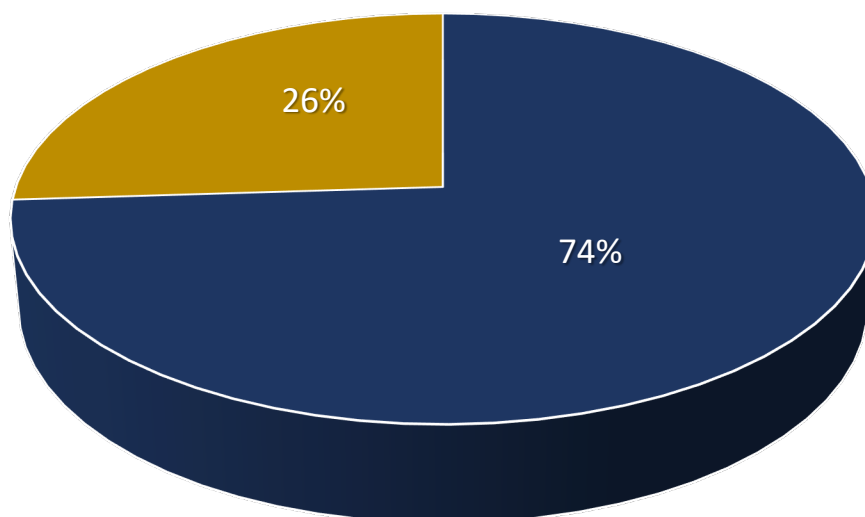

Important Notes

Before the Event

1. Visitors are required to be received **at least 3 doses** of vaccine or **test report** (conducted within last 14 days with negative result, for those with medical reasons/exemptions)
2. When having respiratory symptoms, wear a surgical mask, avoid going to crowded places and seek medical advice promptly. Do not attend the event.

On the Event Day

1. Participants will be required to present vaccination record stored in their **LeaveHomeSafe App** or (for those who are **unfit for vaccination**) valid test result along with a medical exemption certificate **at the gates**.
2. Participants will be required to scan the "**LeaveHomeSafe**" QR code at or nearest to the venue when entering a venue.
3. All participants are required to wear masks throughout the event, except for particular sport activities in specific premises.
4. Hand hygiene should be maintained at all times.
5. No food or drink should be served during the event.
6. A social distance of 1.5 meters should be maintained where possible.

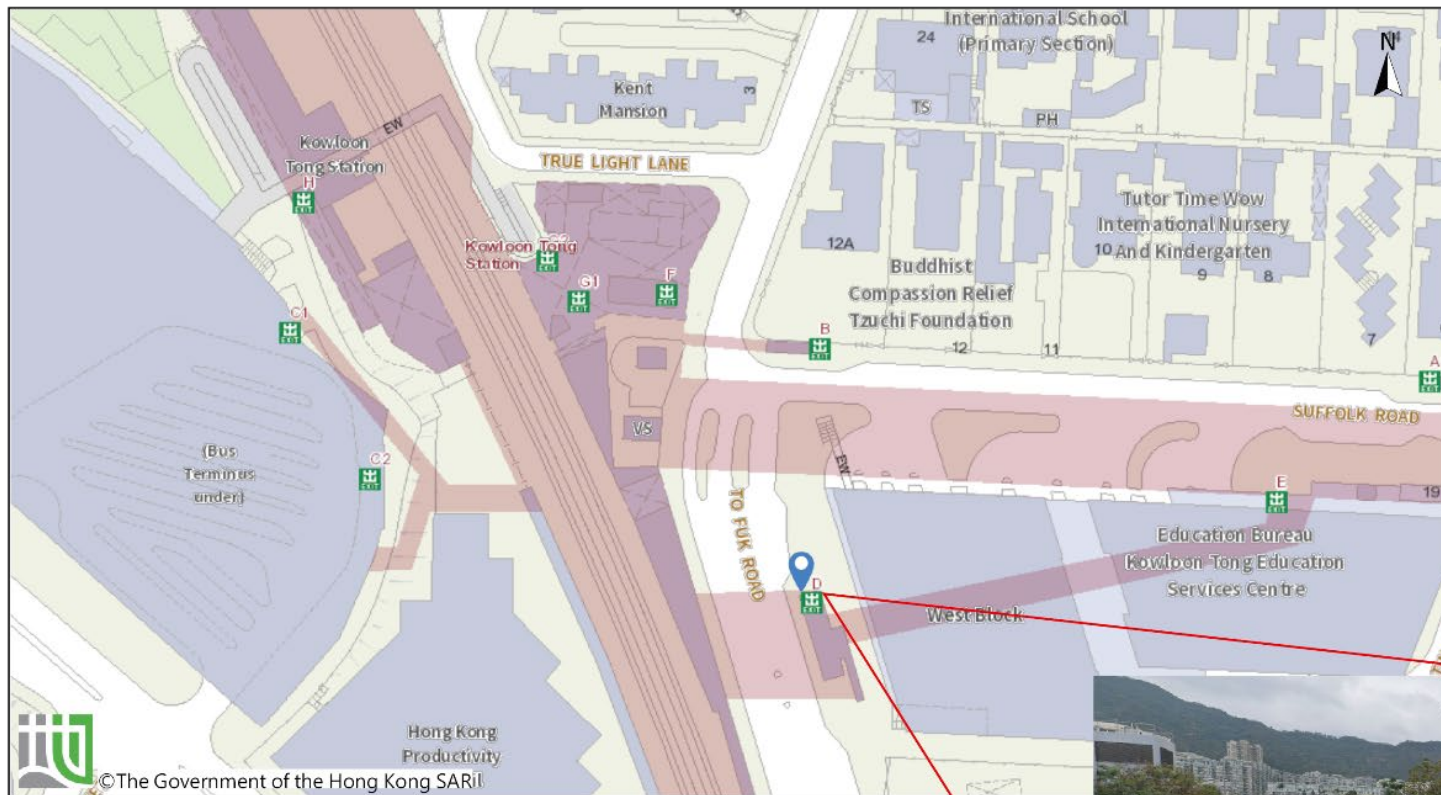

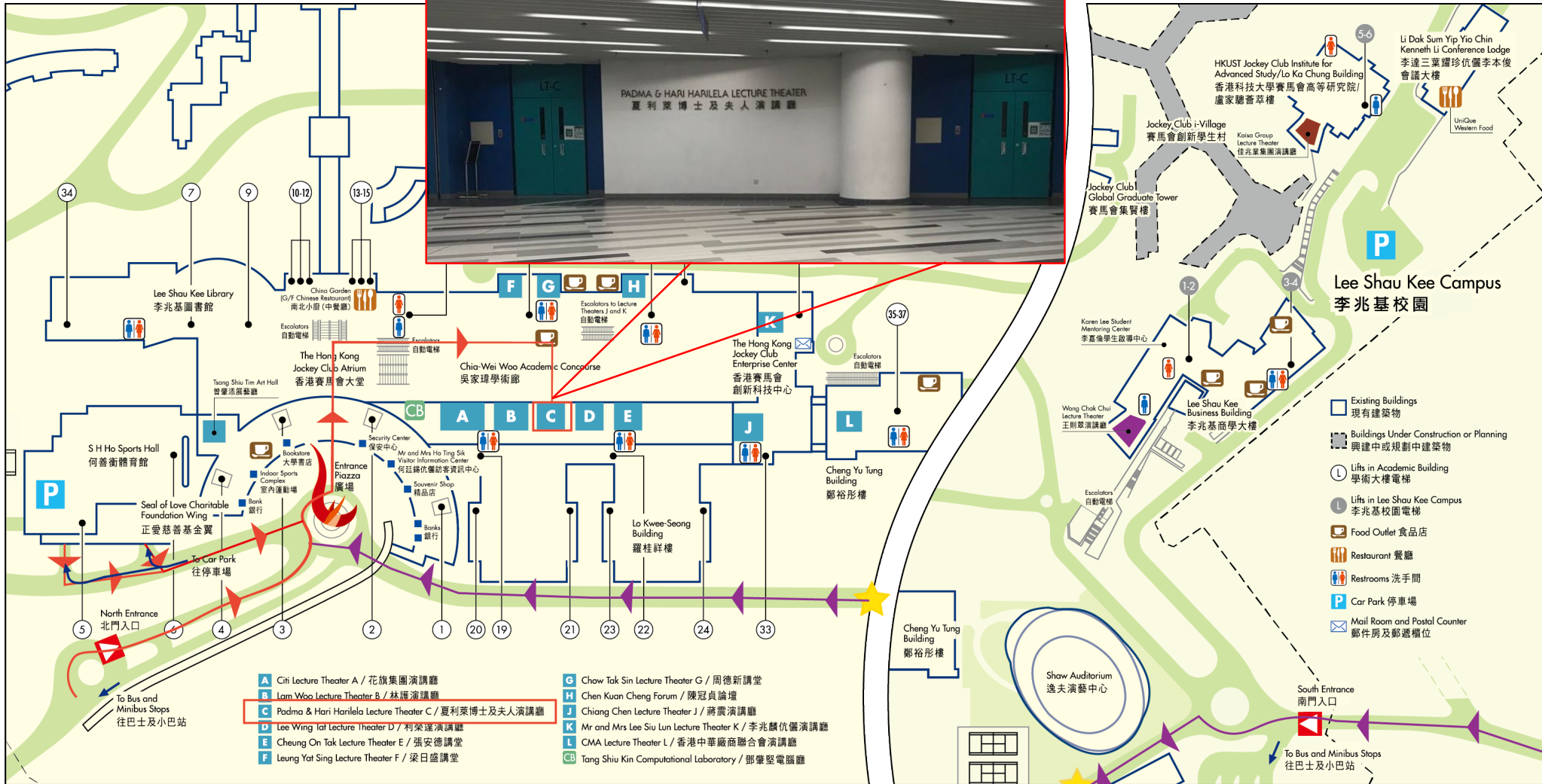
