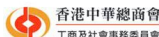

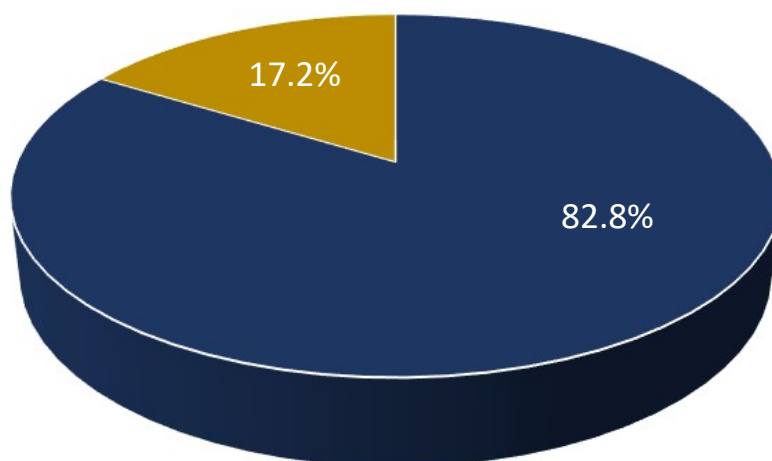

Mandatory Requirement and Health Declaration

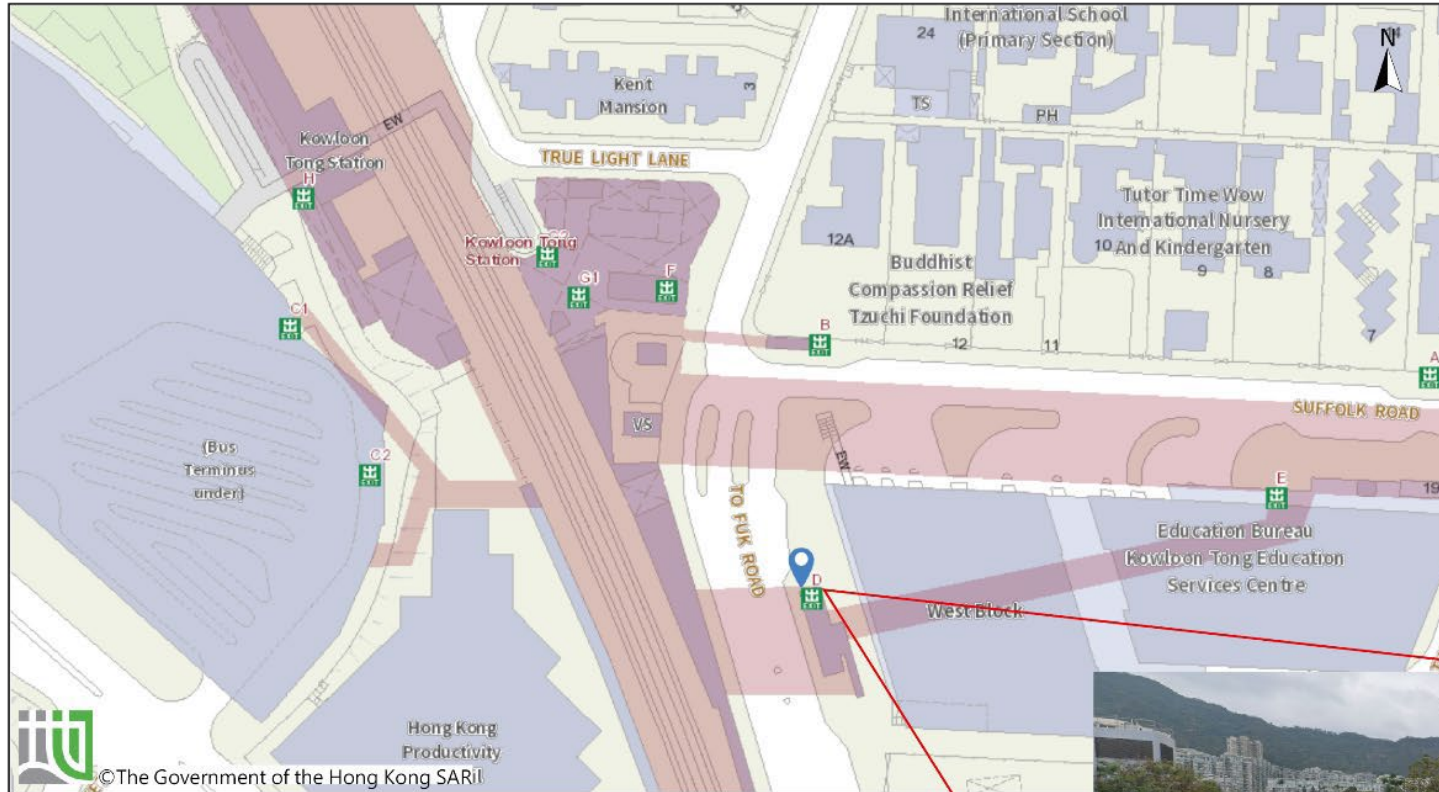

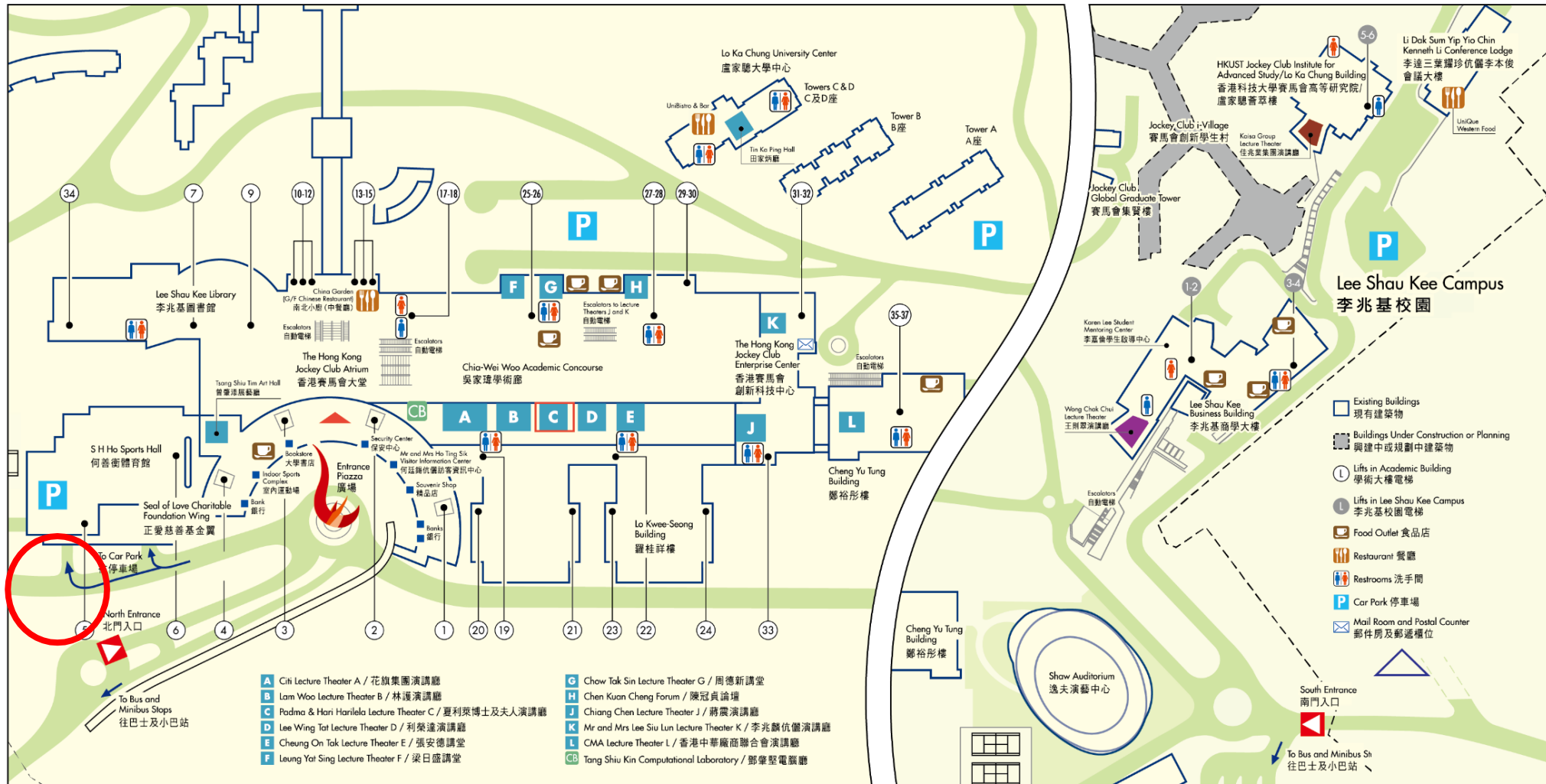
